The number 111 generally speaks to me of the word of the Lord coming to me - it usually is a confirmation that I have heard something from the Lord which He is now confirming that it was Him in deed that spoke = Jer 1:11 Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ... Jer 11:1 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,

9-19-03 Here's a few things on the 11, there is a bit on the number 11 on page 80 of my book too. First, 10 stands for ordinal perfection, and 12 stands for governmental perfection. 11 can mean disorder. It can also represent "approaching the end" or nearing completion - the "11th hour". The prophetic voice crying in the wilderness was like this, "prepare the way of the Lord". You will have to think like a prophet for these next ones - In the first verse in the bible to use the verse prophet, is also the first verse in the bible to use the word pray. Gen 20:7 "Now therefore, restore the man's wife; for he is a prophet, and he will pray for you and you shall live..." this shows us $1+1=$ the prophetic. In Gen 41:32 "And for that the dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice; it is because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass." The word for established should more properly be "confirmed". It happened twice and was confirmed, this is a prophetic attribute. (Acts 14:32 KJV "And Judas and Silas, being prophets also themselves, exhorted the brethren with many words, and confirmed them.") "It will shortly come to pass" is an attribute of both the number 11, and the prophetic. When most people see the two dreams they see them as $1+1=2$, but prophetically we can see them as $1+1=11$. The prophetic is a bridge, between events, between administrations, between change in our lives etc. it is like a bridge in that it helps us "cross over". When I and others were getting the numbers 11, 11 a while back we came up with this verse - Deut 11:11 "but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven." Sort of a prophetic confirmation (11 twice). Also the prophetic usually points a direction, which this verse certainly does. The prophetic is generally edification exhortation, and comfort, it helps us get moving in the direction of our destiny and calling - what the Lord is pointing them towards in their own life, and which direction is He pointing them to the "land which drinks water from the rain of heaven". The knowing of the prophetic alone can bring disorder (11), but the acting upon the prophetic word can bring life (Gen. 20:7), and bring us into a place of blessing, or destiny (Deut 11:11). The prophetic is in much need on mentoring because alone it can bring disorder - but with ordinal wisdom, and governmental wisdom (represented through study and mentoring, 10 & 12), the prophetic brings life. I think we can all recall young "prophets" who were not well grounded in the Word or put a prophetic interpretation above the word, and also those who will not submit or not come into mentoring. These were in that category of "disorderly" - this is the number 11, it is also the prophetic. I just thought of the old song "One is the loneliest number", the prophetic all alone is like loneliness doubled (remember Elijah "I alone am left") - but the Lord said that wasn't the case and sent him to raise up others. He made the cross-over. Well I hope this helps some,

4-12-2001 I wanted to write a short response to the 11:11 post as it has come up a number of times. I thought Joni's post on "The Leaven! The Leaven!" was quite enlightening. It seems a lot of the communication which the Holy Spirit is bringing across the body of Christ is in fact due to the season which we are now entering. I believe it all centers around the 444 and 222 revelations, I'd like to comment on them, but can not at this time. I believe these number revelations are part of His unveiling of secret things, bigger than any of us could quite comprehend yet it is needful that the Lord act in order to bring to pass His will. Deut. 29:29 "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever..."

The 11:11 has been showing up for a time, and more frequently with a number of people. The number 11 in itself is a number which is imperfect, a transitional number, if you will. Between 10, ordinal perfection/ divine order, and 12, governmental order/ divine government. I call it a "bridge" number. It is the number representing the prophetic, which is always a bridge to get us from where we are to where the Lord is directing. Since the number is occurring twice in a row the biblical principle of confirmation comes into play meaning that the subject matter will surely be brought to pass - Gen 41:32 "And the dream was repeated to Pharaoh twice because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass". Recently this number was brought to my attention by a friend who has been given it a number of times recently. She had prayed about it and felt the Lord gave her Duet 11:11 "but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven". With the words "cross over", this verse witnessed to me since 11 is a bridge word. Also the prophetic usually points a direction, which this verse certainly does. I believe it is important to keep in mind with all these signs that we are being shown only a part, and each person is wise to seek council and input (as many are), as to what in their own life the Lord is pointing them towards, and which direction is He pointing them to the "land which drinks water from the rain of heaven".
